


My vet has applied Neptra™ — how does this work to treat ear infections?





Anti-inflammatory

Mometasone

Gets to work quickly to get your dog feeling more comfortable.



Antibiotic

Florfenicol

An antibiotic that treats the most common bacteria found in canine ear infections.1



Anti-fungal

Terbinafine

Treats the fungal infection that is common in ear infections.



1 in 5 dogs suffer from ear infections²

Although ear infections are quite common in dogs, they need to be treated immediately. Ear infections cause inflammation, which can be painful, and there is often also a bacterial or fungal infection in the ear canal.

What is Neptra?

Neptra is a one-dose treatment for ear infections that's only administered by vets in the practice:



If your dog experiences repeated ear infections, it's a good idea to talk to your vet about possible underlying causes which may include allergies.

Your vet may have asked you to come back in a few weeks for a follow-up. It's important you keep that appointment, for your vet to assess the improvement in your dog's ear infection.
