TICKS ARE DANGEROUS

The sheep tick is the most common species of tick in the UK - it spreads Lyme disease, a potentially serious condition that now affects 3,000 Britons a year¹

TICKS ARE SPREADING

Tick numbers are increasing across the UK due to changing weather patterns
- our wetter summers and warmer winters are great conditions for tick survival.





TICKS ARE STRONG

Ticks insert their mouthparts into my skin and 'glue' them in, so never twist a tick to remove it in case it leaves its mouthparts behind.

TICKS WORK HARD

Ticks sit on plants waving their front legs, they grab me as I walk past, attach to me and start feeding on my blood.





TICKS CAN TRAVEL ON ME

When I travel to southern Europe I could bring home a new tick to the UK - the brown dog tick lives inside houses and it can carry babesia disease that's potentially fatal for dogs like me.
