Cameron Sutherland DVM, PhD (Candidate)

Cameron Sutherland is a veterinary parasitologist and PhD candidate at Kansas State University, where he also serves as a Graduate Research Assistant and Parasitology Instructor. His research focuses on the evaluation of ectoparasiticides in companion animals, with active collaborations in regulatory affairs and vector-borne disease surveillance.

Dr. Sutherland, an Elanco Fellow in Veterinary Parasitology, has published on flea and tick control, presented nationally, and supported veterinary education through teaching, diagnostics, and student mentorship. Join us for an evidence-based discussion on advances in feline flea management, featuring new data from a recently completed field study conducted in Florida.
