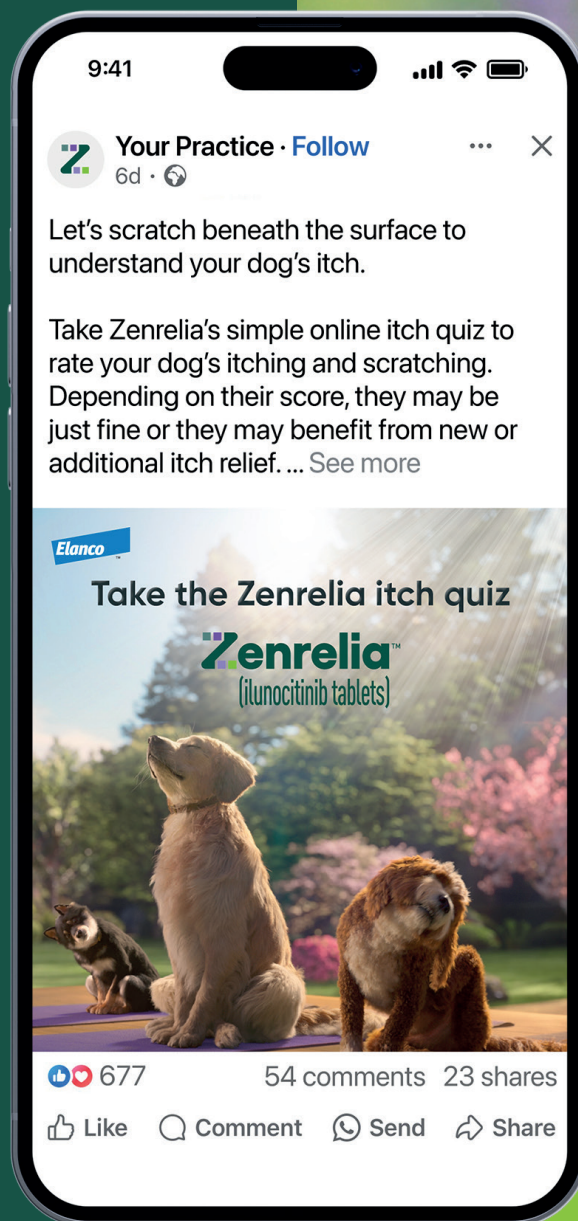

How to create a Facebook Post

Using your phone or desktop:

1. Select **"Create a post"** on your clinic's Facebook page.
2. Copy and paste the provided copy into the space on your new post.
3. Select the **"Photo/video"** option and attach the provided image.
4. Be sure to add alt text by clicking the ellipsis in the upper right corner of the image.
5. Double-check that all text tagging another account is active; this is indicated by a light blue highlight over the top of the tagged name.
6. Copy and paste the provided copy into your new post and hit **"Publish."** Hashtags are not necessary on Facebook.

How to create an Instagram Post

Using your phone or desktop:

1. Select the **"+"** button at the bottom of the mobile app or select **"+ Create"** from the left-side navigation on your desktop to create a post on your clinic's Instagram page.
2. Choose the selected image for the post; do not apply a filter, and proceed to the caption. To add alt text to the image, select **"advanced settings"** at the bottom of the screen before posting for greater accessibility.

3. Copy and paste the provided copy into your new post and hit **"Share."**
4. To maximize character count, hashtags should be entered into the first comment of the Instagram post and NOT the copy.
5. Once you have posted your image to Instagram, paste the following hashtags as a comment under your caption and hit **"Post."** To ensure these hashtags stay at the top of the comment section, swipe left on the comment and select the pin icon.

WARNING: INADEQUATE IMMUNE RESPONSE TO VACCINES. Based on results of the vaccine response study, dogs receiving Zenrelia are at risk

of an inadequate immune response to vaccines. Discontinue Zenrelia for at least 28 days to 3 months prior to vaccination and withhold Zenrelia for at least 28 days after vaccination. Dogs should be up to date on vaccinations prior to starting Zenrelia. Do not use in dogs less than 12 months old or dogs with a serious infection. Dogs should be monitored for infections because Zenrelia may increase the chances of developing an infection. Neoplastic conditions (benign and malignant) were observed during clinical studies. The most common side effects were vomiting, diarrhea and tiredness.

Zenrelia has not been tested in dogs used for breeding, pregnant, or lactating dogs and has not been evaluated in combination with glucocorticoids, cyclosporine, or other immune suppressive drugs.
