Contraindications:	This product is contraindicated for use in calves less than 200kg (under 1 year old). This product is contraindicated for use in cattle of unknown copper status or those treated with other sources of copper.
	Excessive copper is toxic. This product is contraindicated for use in cattle suffering from jaundice and other liver disorders such as liver fluke, or stock grazing plants containing toxic alkaloids, e.g. Heliotrope, Ragwort, Patersons Curse (Salvation Jane).
	Seek the advice of a veterinary or cattle husbandry specialist to ascertain copper deficiency and type of treatment required for cattle under consideration.

Dosage and Administration:	Adult cattle over 200 kg – one capsule per head annually administered orally.
General Directions:	Dose cows early in pregnancy to allow protection of young calves against copper deficiency.
	To be effective the capsule must be swallowed. Use the correct administrator, which delivers the capsules directly into the gullet.
	In areas where liver fluke are endemic, stock should be treated with a highly effective flukicide at least three weeks before dosing with this copper supplement.
