

Your dog loves to get out and explore the outdoors, making every walk an adventure!

They love heading off-leash to sniff through the woods, splash in a stream, or a get together with some doggy friends, they're always ready for action!

They also cannot resist picking up and ingesting everything they find, as they love to add more protein to their diet!

Your dog may be at risk and require regular protection from **roundworms**, **hookworms**, **whipworms**, **ticks** and **fleas**.

As your dog loves to find all sorts of tasty treats, your dog may be at risk for **tapeworms**, which can be zoonotic. Ask your veterinarian if you live in an endemic area for *Echinococcus multilocularis* or *Echinococcus granulosus*.
